Note 1: Mortuaries without on-site funeral chapels are All County, A Special Touch, Bay Area Cremation, Byrgan's, Cunningham's, and Lamorinda.

Funeral and memorial services can be held at churches, cemetery chapels, homes, YMCA, lodges, hotels, or other locations.

Note 2: Bodies may be stored and/or embalmed at a different location than the mortuary's listed address. Most cremation containers (included) are heavy cardboard and hold up to 240 lbs. A more costly container and higher crematory fee can be expected for heavier persons. Also included: a plastic or cardboard container for cremated remains, all transportation. The mortuary personnel will wash and dress the body for B1 and B2 plans for an additional fee. It is included in B3. Payment policies of each mortuary may differ, ask.

Note 3: The plus sign (+) after the mortuary name indicates the mortuary will accept FCA members who have died, whether they have pre-planned or not.

POLICIES AND SOME EXTRA CHARGES FOR MORTUARY SERVICES

Rush jobs, sales taxes, disposition fees, death certificates, obituaries, coroner fees, cemetery costs, or witnessed cremations will cost extra. Look at the mortuary's General Price List. Here are some common extra charges that may apply when you deviate from the five basic funeral plans.
